## **GIFT AID**

You may be aware that the Inland Revenue allows charities to reclaim tax back on subscriptions. Previously known as Deed of Covenant, this is now called Gift Aid and allows anyone who is a taxpayer to simply sign an agreement authorising the charity to reclaim the income tax part of the annual subscription payment (or any other donation).

It would be beneficial to the Society if all members would take part in the Gift Aid scheme and below is a form which, if you are willing to do so are a taxpayer you should complete and return to the Society. On a membership subscription of £30, it means that we are able to reclaim £8 from the Government!

### **THERE IS NO EXTRA COST TO YOU, THE MEMBER!**

If you cease to be a taxpayer for any reason, you should let the Society know as soon as possible and your Gift Aid declaration will become void.
